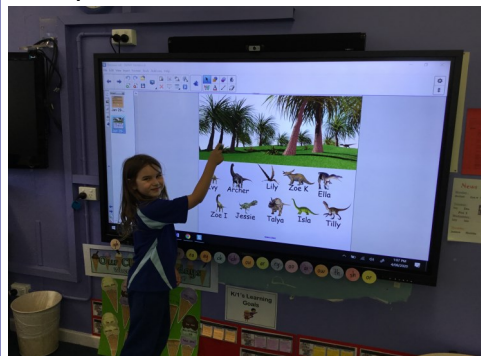



3D Printer

The 5/6 class have been experimenting with a 3D printer for the last little while. Initially they were using it to experiment with and create pieces in a bridge building unit.
