CONGRATULATIONS MIA

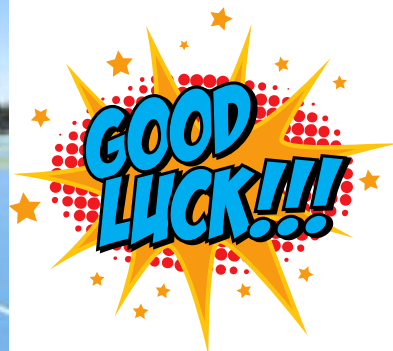
